National Volunteer Week

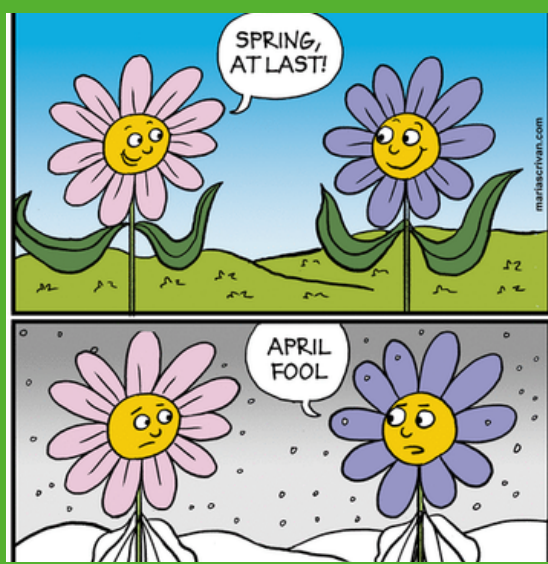
